





Registration Is Open for WAPOA's Grandpa's Run for the Walleye

Registration is open for the 25th Annual Grandpa's 5K Run for the Walleve. Grandpa's Run for the Walleye has become one of the signature events of the Crosslake 4th of July Celebration and will be held on the morning of Saturday, July 2nd, the same day as the fireworks over Cross Lake.

The event, based at the Crosslake Community Center, begins with the 5K Run/Walk at 8:30 AM, and culminating with the Kids Sunfish Dash at 9:45 AM.
